

# Jim & Shirley's Secret Spots

This is #2 in our series of articles on where to go to take pictures just like the ones in this article.

Yuba Gap, Placer County: In the winter: Take the Yuba Gap freeway off-ramp on I80 just east of Emigrant Gap. Turn left and cross the overpass to the north side of the freeway and park. Walk out on the overpass and look east at the on-coming freeway traffic. Above the freeway and slightly left you will see a range of mountains which run from Grouse Ridge on the left to Old Man mountain on the right. Red mountain is to the right of Old Man Mountain. This location is great after a new snow. Shoot when there are clouds above the mountains if possible.

Cross back over the over-crossing and follow the Snow Mt. Road for about ¼ mi. Parking is not permitted along this road, but the attached sun thru the clouds snow pic was taken by me jumping out of the car for a quick snap. Remove powerlines in post.

Take the first turn to the right and you are on the Lake Valley Reservoir Rd. This is a public rd. (no parking on the rd.) but is snow-plowed by the church camp at the reservoir. If the snow is deep you will not be able to turn around on this dead-end rd. I can do it most of the time in the jeep, but beware, since I have had to back out for more than a mile. Shoot the small "Indian Lake" on the left seen buried in snow in this pic. Shoot the trees and meadows with new snow and good lighting.

In the springtime and summer: This road is also good in the springtime and summer with lots of wildflowers in 6 mile valley on your left (along Kelly Creek) and around Indian Lake. There is 30 miles of dirt back-country roads past the reservoir in the summer. You can also take the jeep road down to the river to the right( an old burn area) just as you leave 6 mile valley with an Osprey nest nearby and tons of wild flowers. For more information on the backcountry in this area call me.


