





Red Rock Canyon


California's Fall Color by G. Dan Mitchell

Available on Amazon is a new CA Fall Color guide. In its 117 pages you'll find an extensive guide to locations, technique, and even etiquette. It concentrates on the Central Sierra from Tahoe, Hope Valley and Hwy 89 to Bishop and the back country East of there. Mainly following Hwy 395 it features "Side Trips" that go up the intersecting canyons. There is additional information about the Trans-Sierra Passes and Yosemite.

For the area it covers it does a pretty good job. The author feels his guide will get you to the main locations and encourages you to branch out & find your own "special places". He covers plenty of places you may not know about or would like to be reminded about when you're in the area. For the Amazon price of \$13.18 it's well worth the cost.

The traditional peak of Fall Color in The Eastern Sierra is the second week of October, Yosemite Valley a couple of weeks later, and the area East of Bishop starts earlier in the higher elevations. Timing is not precise and in this dry year it's likely to be earlier. If you Google "California Fall Color Reports" you find blogs that follow the reports of the color's progress throughout the season. There are a variety of resorts and tourist bureaus that update conditions regularly on the web.




Hi Placer Camera Club Members
